This is follow up to questions that were asked at the Budget Workshop on January 14, 2020. Mr. Mancusi will respond to the questions on special education in a separate memo.

1. What is the correlation between SBA and PSAT grade 9?

Based on a study by the CTSDE, the correlation between the PSAT-9 and the SBA-8 is 0.796 and 0.778 for ELA and math, respectively. In Fairfield the correlation between the SBA-8 and PSAT-9 are 0.765 and 0.850 for ELA and math, respectively.

2. What is the overall athletic participation, disaggregated by gender? Team numbers if possible

3. Please provide details on hours/days for athletic trainers and conditioning coaches. How many athletic trainers and conditioning coaches do you have? How many days per week do they work and how many hours per day?

Each Athletic Trainer works 40 hours a week. This includes weekends when necessary for game coverage. For the most part, every varsity game is covered and many subvarsity games are as well. Each conditioning coach works 10 hours a week – 2hrs/day M-F. Each school gets one AT and one strength coach.

Attached is additional information requested by Board members in attendance at the January 13, 2020 budget meeting. The following documents are attached:

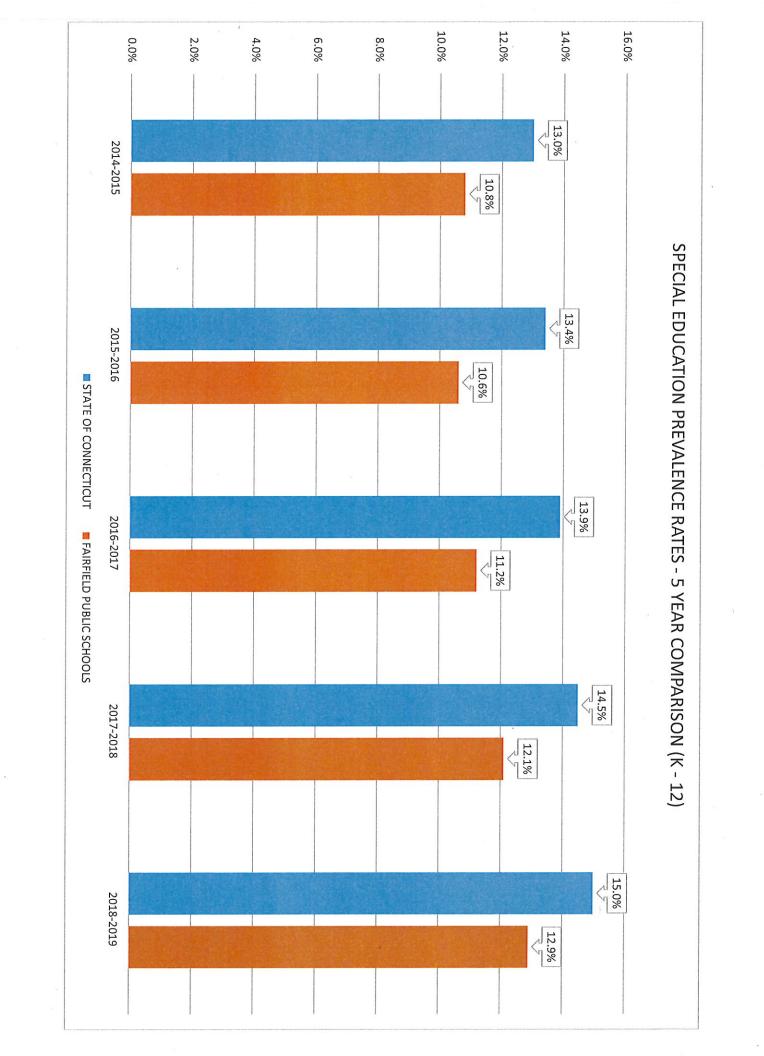
- Ten-year comparison of special education enrollment by disability for students pre-K-21 years of age

I will be happy to answer any additional questions each of you may have relative to the information enclosed.

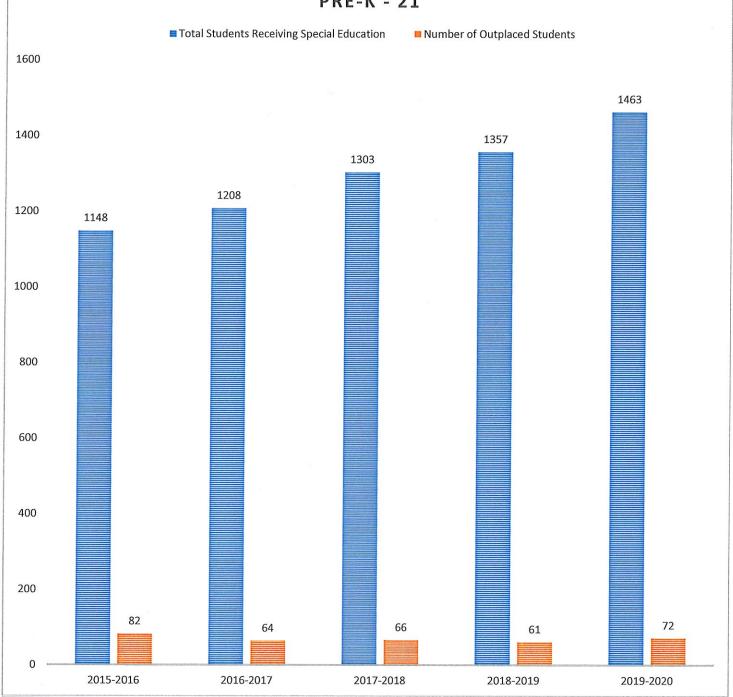

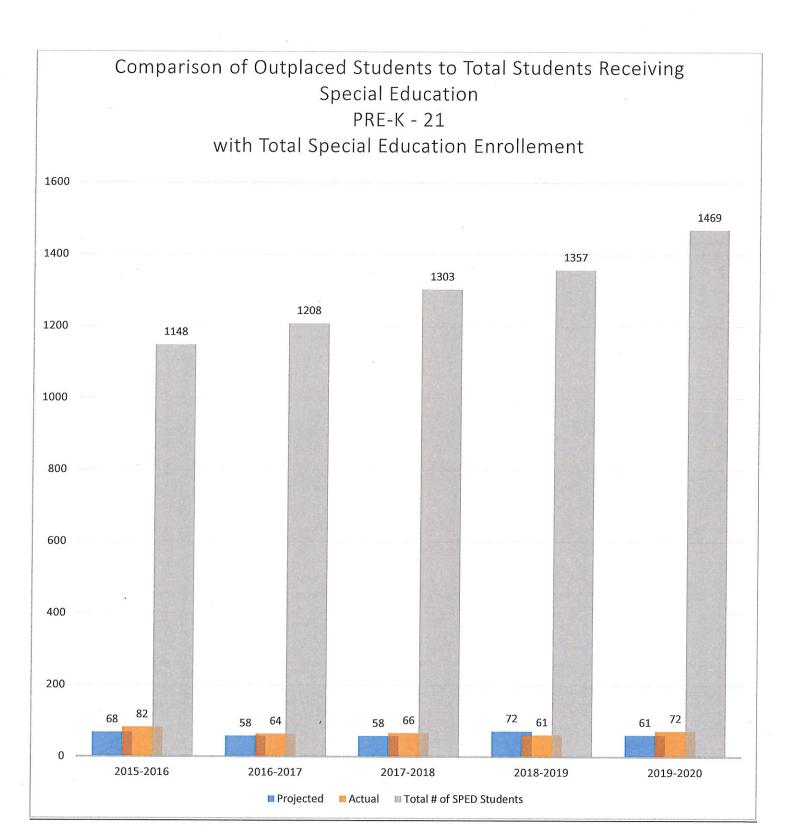
