Purpose: Answer one question

If you had to choose today...

Full Time, In-Person

or

Remote

Answer: It depends

- Responses reflect confusion and frustration
- Given a binary choice, parents set their own conditions
 - 2,221 survey comments; 520+ link/website comments
- Total responses: 6028 Students (3625 surveys)
- Not a representative sample of the district
 - Random sample vs. opt-in
 - Heavily skewed to elementary and hybrid
 - Cannot be used as planning numbers

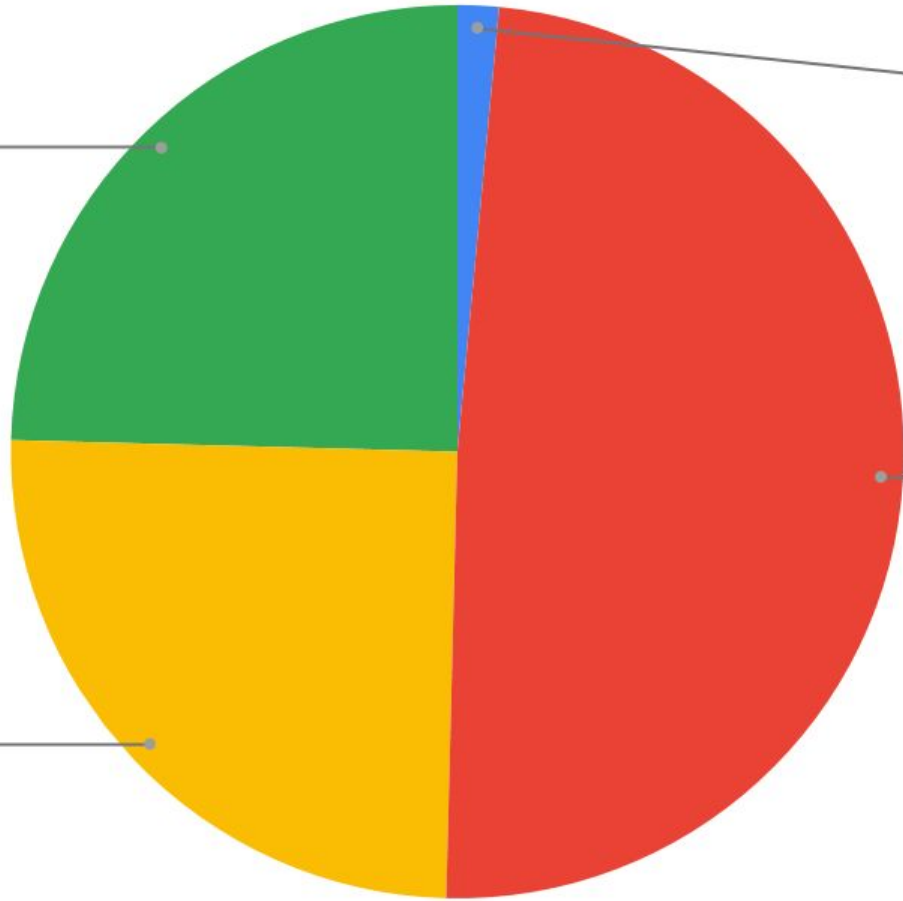
Response by Grade Level

24.6%

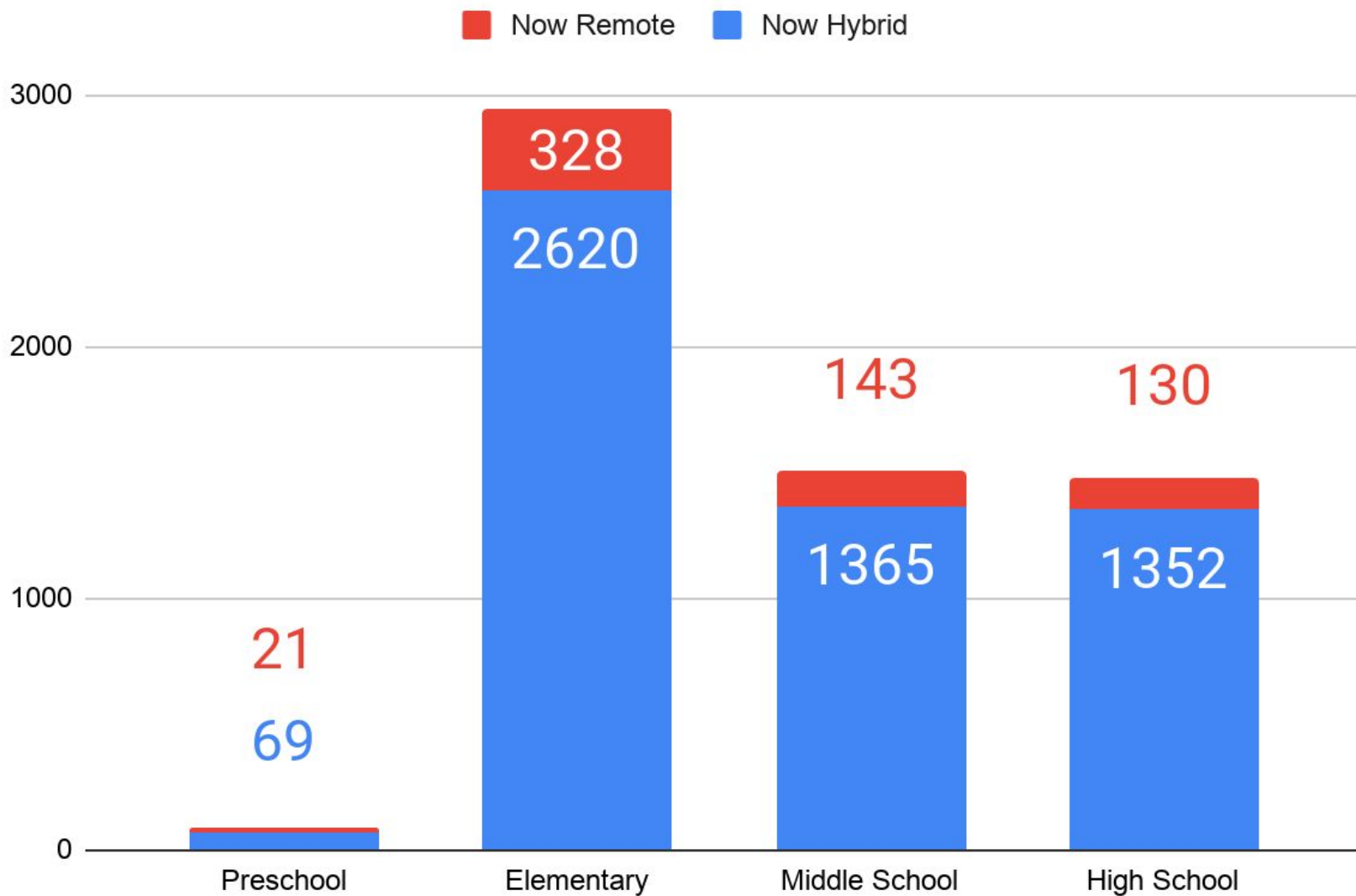
Middle School

1.5%

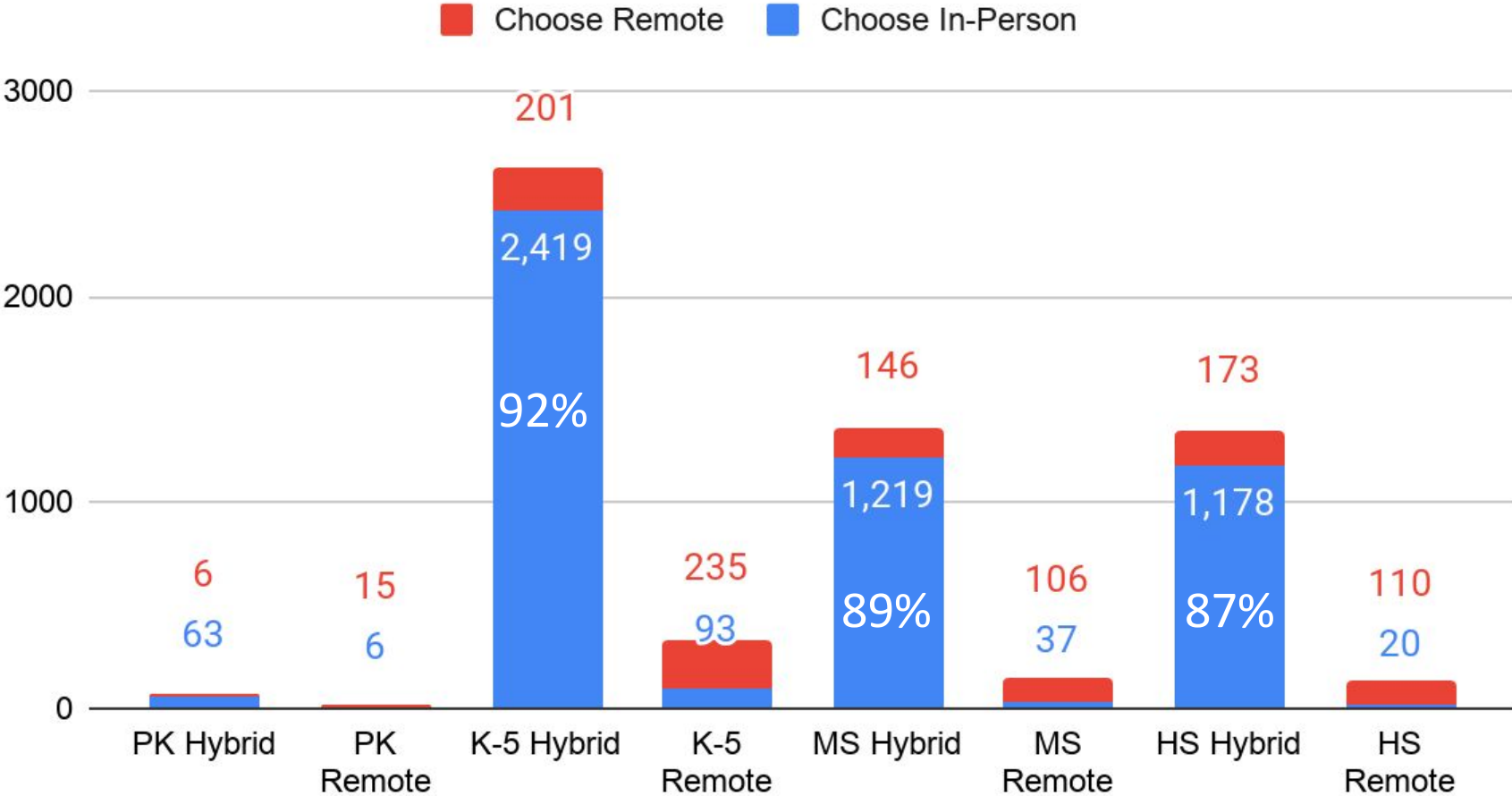
Elementary
48.9%



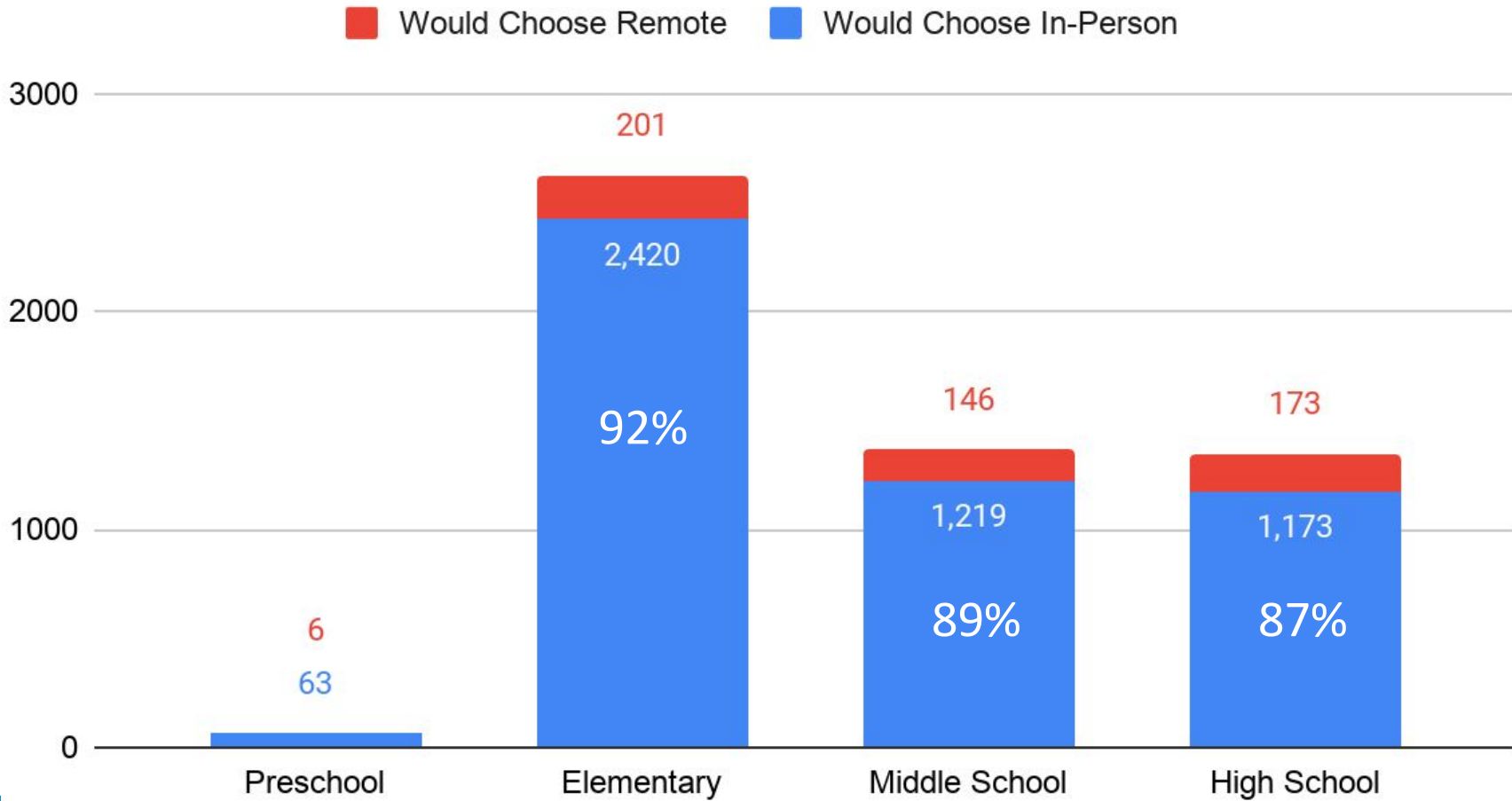
Response by Current Enrollment



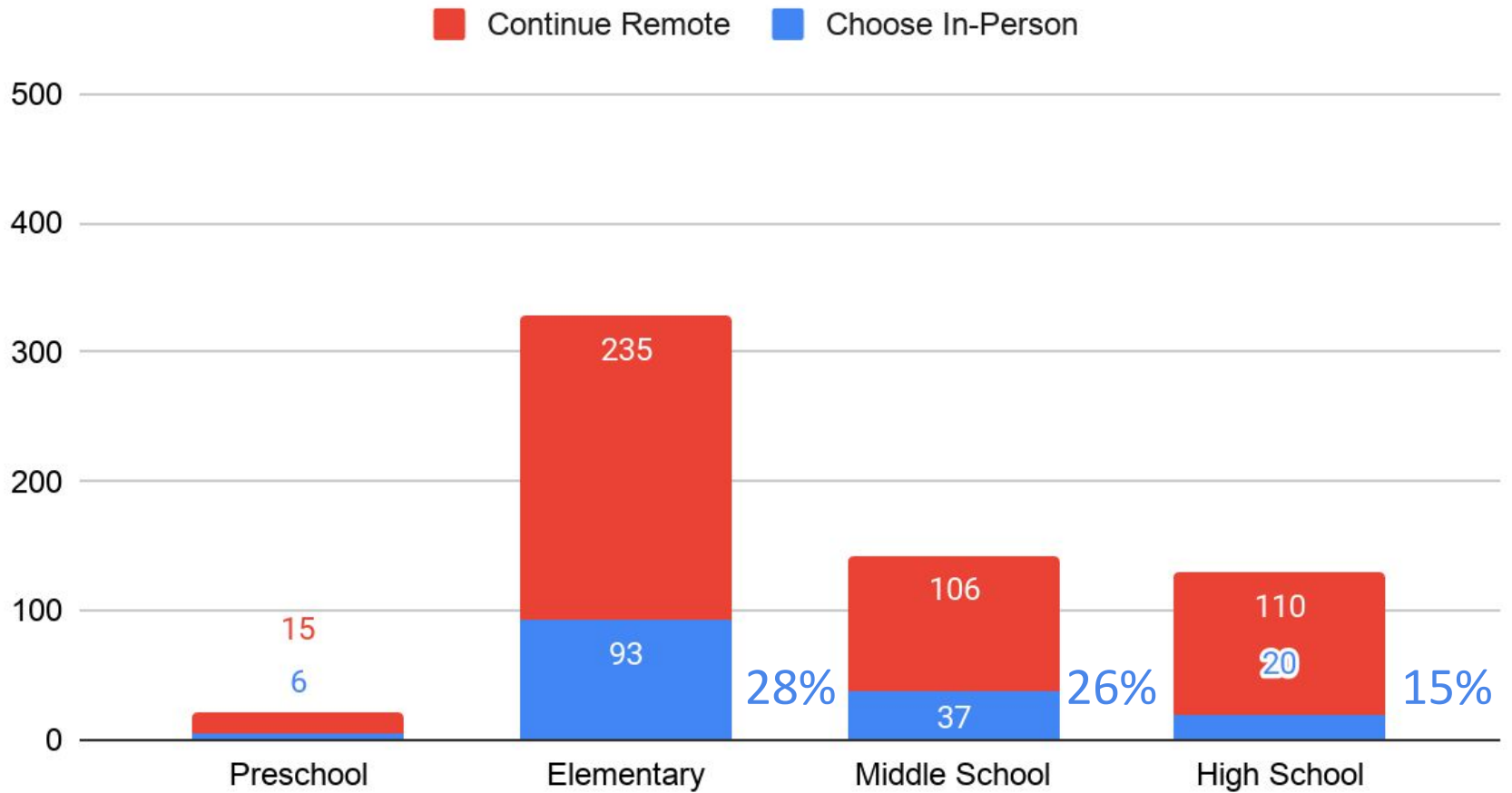
Choice by Current Model

What the numbers don't show

- Many who want to stay in hybrid were frustrated by the survey and did not complete it.
 - No option continue with hybrid
- Choice to return is highly conditional (~30%)
 - Current health data, flu season, vaccine availability, on-site testing, maintain 6 feet distance, restrict sports, lunch plans, ability to switch
 - Concerns about Elementary livestream engagement / participation vs. RLA as remote option

Next Steps

- Establish timeline / specific details
 - Data indicates what parents need to know to decide
 - Drive communications plan
 - Ask for parent commitment
