Re: Summer BOOST Enrollment

The Summer BOOST Program began on Tuesday, July 5, 2022, and will run for 17 days from 8:30 am until 12:30 pm. The elementary program includes students who were in grades K-4 during the 2021-2022 school year and Mary Dolan-Collette is serving as the program principal. The secondary program includes students who were in grades 5-8 during the 2021-2022 school year and Peter Shanazu is serving as the program principal. A total of 209 out of 602 invitees, accepted placement in the program. The following table provides the breakdown of the number of students invited to the program and the number of students who accepted the invitation:

Re: District Improvement Plan Response

During the District Improvement Plan inquiry sessions, Mrs. Maxon-Kennelly inquired to Mr. Cummings about the class of 2023 and the percentage of students who met the mastery-based [graduation requirements](#).

The class of 2023 is required to achieve a cut score of 480 (language arts) and 530 (math) on the SAT for .5 mastery-based credits. There are other indicators that can be substituted in lieu of the SAT requirement (e.g.: district portfolio, ACT, AP assessments).

The data below indicate the percentage of students (class of 2023) who have met the testing requirements through the SAT and NGSS assessment. Other data points were not calculated percentages below.

Expectation	Percent Meeting the expectation
Met the Graduation Requirement (2 assessments)	75.7%
Met the Language Arts Testing Expectation (480 or higher)	84.3%
Met the Mathematics Testing Expectation (530 or higher)	63.1%
Met the Science Testing Expectation (1099 or higher)	62.77%
