Re: 2023-2024 Grade Six Math Acceleration

Grade six mathematics for elementary students currently enrolled in grade five mathematics as fourth graders will take place next year at Roger Ludlowe Middle School and Holland Hill Elementary School.

The locations were chosen as both Holland Hill and Roger Ludlowe Middle School begin at the same time. Participating Holland Hill students will not lose any instructional time due to travel. Student groups were evenly divided. Eighteen students are anticipated in each cohort.

The following standards were considered in the development of the program:

- Math instruction will remain sixty minutes each day.
- Elementary students will begin their day at 8:10 and end by 9:20 in both locations. Students will then be transported back to their home elementary school and participate with their class for the remainder of the day. No instructional periods will be lost in any building.
- Fifth grade peers will start their day with math in each elementary school.
- Elementary principals will be strategic in placement of the remainder of the instructional blocks, including when specials are delivered in grade five.
- Orchestra and Band rehearsal (grade 5) will continue to take place in the morning. Once these schedules are solidified with shared staff, we will set up a schedule for math acceleration students to participate in rehearsal on an intermittent basis. As a result, they will not be present for some sixth-grade math days.

Parents were informed of next year's program on Thursday, April 6, 2023 and asked to respond with acceptance by April 21, 2023.
