Re: Changes to the Transition to College Math Curriculum Implementation

In the fall of 2023, the math department met to review and discuss curriculum implementation courses. In the current school year (2023-2024), students are enrolled in Transition to College Math for the entire school year. Upon successful completion of the course, students earn 1.0 credit.

To provide additional scheduling options and flexibility to students, starting in the 2024-2025 school year, we will offer two semester courses (Transition to College Math A and Transition to College Math B) for a half (.50) credit each. The current board approved Transition to College Math curriculum will not change. The curriculum content will be separated into two semester courses. Students may enroll in semester A, semester B or both. Completion of semester A is not required for enrollment in semester B course.
