Re: Computer Assisted Design II (CAD) - Changes to Curriculum from February 13, 2024

Three grammatical errors were found on the CAD II document presented to the Fairfield Board of Education on February 13, 2024. They have been edited and updated in the March 12, 2024 document included with the agenda.

The changes include:

- Unit 4 Skills change the capital A to a lowercase a in the word apply.
- Unit 5 Content change the capital *I* to a lowercase *i* in the word *industry*.
- Unit 6 Resources remove the period after the word consumables.
