VENDING MACHINES

3542.45

The Board of Education delegates to the Superintendent or designee the authority to make decisions on the placement of food and beverage vending machines in the schools. This includes whether such machines may be installed, where they would be placed, what items would be dispensed, and during which hours they might be used. All revenue produced from this source shall be deposited in the designated fund as directed by the Superintendent or designee.
