INSTRUCTION - GENERAL

6010

The Board of Education believes the instructional program of the public schools to be among its highest priorities, and it is therefore important for the Board and the professional staff to work cooperatively in determining educational goals and objectives that meet the needs of students.

Within the budget provided by the Town, the Board of Education will provide personnel, equipment, instructional supplies and materials, and other support required to meet professional staff needs and community goals. The Board, recognizing that education is continually evolving, supports on-going professional development for certified and non-certified staff.

The Superintendent of Schools or designee shall present regular evidence of student progress and of program modifications based on evaluations that are consistent with district goals and objectives. Evidence of educational outcomes is important in evaluating the educational system, guiding improvement efforts, and developing public support for the schools.
