Dear Mr. Tracy:

I am writing in response to your request for an extension of time to present the proposed amendment to the Fairfield Board of Education's racial imbalance plan for McKinley School. I had originally scheduled the matter for the Connecticut State Board of Education (CSBE) meeting on December 7, 2016. In our telephone conversation earlier this week, you indicated that the Fairfield Board of Education had recently hired Dr. Toni Jones as the Superintendent of Fairfield Public Schools. She will begin her employment as of December 5, 2016, which would not allow her sufficient time to prepare for the CSBE meeting.

After reviewing your request, the Connecticut State Board of Education (CSBE) Chairperson and Vice Chairperson have agreed to an extension, which will allow Dr. Jones to present the district's racial imbalance amendment at the regular meeting of the CSBE on January 4, 2017. While I had originally indicated that you must submit your district's amended plan no later than November 15, 2016, you may submit this plan by November 18th since I understand that the Fairfield Board will be voting on this plan at its November 15th meeting.

The following student international travel trips for our secondary schools have been approved by the administration. In an effort to maintain consistent instructional practices, no staff or students will miss more than two (2) full days of school for any field trip.

At the October 26, 2004 meeting, the Board of Education lifted the ban on foreign travel and delegated the approval for such trips to the Superintendent of Schools.

The first day of Passover is April 11, 2017, with the last day of Passover being April 18, 2017. Good Friday will occur on April 14, 2017. Spring recess for staff and students begins on April 10, 2017 and ends on April 14, 2017.

FAIRFIELD LUDLOWE HIGH SCHOOL

Destination: Madrid and Talavera Spain

Date of Trip: April 6-15, 2017

Teacher Responsible: Eileen Frankel

Estimated Cost of Trip: \$2,800.00 (per person)

Number of Students Attending: Approximately 8-16

Number of Chaperones: 2 - 3

During this trip, students will have the opportunity to experience first-hand the culture and language of Spain.

During this trip, students will experience evaluating textile use in designs, evaluating proper construction techniques, evaluate the roles of theories in the fashion movement and interpret fashion as an integrated global entity. They will prepare and evaluate recipes from a foreign country, observe and take part in a culinary institute classroom, students will participate in hands-on cooking classes in a culinary institute and observe and participate in the supply and distribution of foods in a foreign country. Students will share their learnings with other classes.

During this trip, students will learn new techniques and discover new technology to apply to our Graphics and Computer program at FWHS.

Number of Chaperones: 18 (includes parents)


