Table 1: Percent of 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Students Recommended for Pre-Algebra-7

School Year	Percent of Students
2014-2015	2.6%
2013-2014	2.1%
2012-2013	1.8%
2011-2012	2.0%
2010-2011	1.5%
2009-2010	1.3%
