## TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES

4121.1 4221.1

The Board of Education has the responsibility to employ such persons as may be needed to conduct the business of the school district, on a temporary basis. Such employment requires the official action of the Board of Education.

The Board of Education recognizes that there are times when extraordinary conditions warrant that the Superintendent of Schools hire temporary personnel in advance of official action by the Board in order to ensure the continuity of the district's functions and program. Any such action shall be promptly reported at the Board and subject to the Board's action at the next Board meeting.

## **INTERNSHIPS**

The Board may appoint administrative interns to provide training for staff members interested in careers in administration.
